This position will serve as the Research and Assessment Director for the College of Nursing Office of Research and Evaluation and Center for Health Science Research. This purpose of this position is to enhance and promote the research activities of the faculty of the College of Nursing and the Center for Health Science Research; to implement and administer policies and procedures pertaining to the submission of successful proposals, to assist with the development of contracts, subcontracts, etc.; and to facilitate the management of all awards and contracts for the College of Nursing and the Center for Health Science Research. Eighty-five percent of the work effort of this position will be dedicated to research activities and the remaining time will focus on the assessment and evaluation activities in the College of Nursing.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Experience: Two to three years of research or assessment office experience is preferred; accounting and budget preparation experience is desired. Supervisory experience preferred.

Proficiency with grant proposal software including Grants.gov and FastLane desired. Must have extensive communication, organizational and analytical skills as well as demonstrated ability to effectively conduct training sessions in large groups or individually.
