

How to Start Helping Investigators Finding Funding opportunities?	
Meet with your PIs to discuss their research portfolio and their situation: What are the KEY WORDS that best describe their RESEARCH? Which type of are they looking for? For Research? For Mentoring? For Conference? Amount? Duration? Any PI eligibility restrictions to take in consideration? Junior PI vs faculty vs tenured faculty vs Professor? Publication record? Citizenship? Age? Years of experience? Any additional criteria? Any specific sponsor in mind?

 Discuss what you found with your PI. Set up alerts directly with this funding agency to receive notifications when
