The University of Missouri's (MU) Office of Strategic Proposal Development Services (SPDS) is a unit within the Office of Research and Economic Development (ORED). SPDS provides grant writing support services to Principal Investigators and academic units to plan, write, and submit large, complex, interdisciplinary, and multi-investigator proposals for priority funding agencies.

### **Available Positions**

### **Proposal Development Lead**

- Prepare narrative of external grant proposals, particularly large, complex, interdisciplinary proposals.
- Coordinate gather, maintain, and disseminate materials and information to support grant writing by faculty.
- · Conduct post-submission reviews and analysis.

### **Proposal Manager**

- Provide project management driven by timelines, progress, action items, and deadlines.
- Support interdisciplinary strategic proposals that are aligned with the University of Missouri's research mission.

### **Grants and Contacts Specialist**

- Complete sponsor-required forms for external funding (e.g., sponsor budget form, administrative portions of applications) and enter data into sponsor submission system.
- Prepare internal documents for external funding (e.g., MU compliance documentation, sub-recipient forms).

### **Proposal Editor**

- Provide detailed proposal editing services focused on accuracy, readability, and compliance with funding agency guidelines.
- · Offer recommendations based on experience, judgement, and precedence to faculty and colleagues.

### **Proposal Illustrator**

- Produce tables, charts, and figures using common communication tools, such as Excel, Visio, Tableau, or Adobe Suite.
- Interpret narrative content and develop representative, professional, complex yet easily understood graphics.
