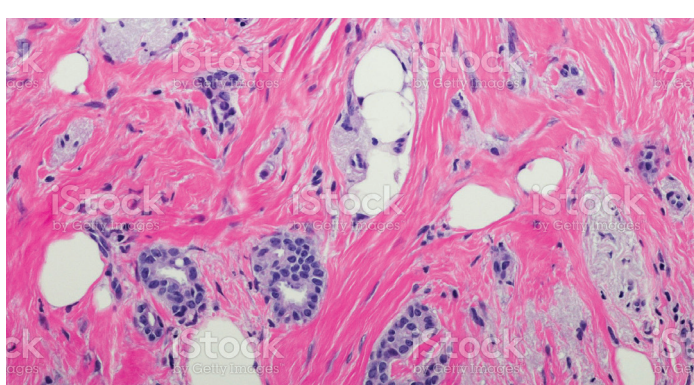
5th Annual Multidisciplinary Breast Oncology Symposium
